

From CEPALC:



Phoebe participated in a series of workshops led by Yesid (CEPALC worker) in various indigenous communities. In Calle Larra (neighbourhood)

Phoebe spoke about the financial autonomy and freedom of decision making that women must claim as their right. The work being done in this neighbourhood has become a true

model of affirmation of indigenous culture with its school radio, dance groups, drums, theatre and radio programs tackling indigenous people's issues. At the workshops, they then met with 35 women from the Zenu Culture Makers Association in the Siria neighbourhood. There the women gave a report on the results of the sesame and bean planting activity they did with the help of CEPALC. A women's empowerment workshop was also held, where Phoebe was one of the facilitators.



They then visited and led workshops for the first time in the Berlin and Alianza neighbourhoods. In Berlin, the project objective is to turn the school into an audio-visual production school that creates videos, radio programs and photography. In Alianza, a radio training school was created, and

every three days five students travel to town of San Andrés de Sotavento to participate in the production of programs for the radio station that broadcasts to the entire town. Phoebe led workshops with Yesid to strengthen the self-esteem of the young people since there are some cases of suicide in that community.
