# **Lifting of Restrictions**

As government restrictions have now been lifted in England, the managing trustees must decide what restrictions are necessary for the building and the groups that use them. Guidance has been given on **Coronavirus Guidance for Property** but the final decision rests with the managing trustees. Further guidance from the government can be found **here**.
