INDEPENDENT EXAMINERS UNQUALIFIED REPORT

Independent Examiner's report to the Trustees of Wesley Methodist Church.

I report on the accounts of the church for the year ended 31 August 2000 which are set out on the accompanying pages.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner.

As the charity trustees, you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts; you consider that the audit requirements of Section 43 (2) of the Charities Act 1993 (the Act) do not apply.
