A PLACE WHERE ALL ARE WELCOME

3Generate, as part of the Methodist Church, aims to create a diverse and inclusive space where all are welcome regardless of church background, race, theology, gender, sexuality and age. We all have a role to play in making sure everyone feels respected and safe.

This year on the Saturday of 3Gen we will be welcoming 4-7 year olds and their families into the town. They will be with us from 10am to 4pm. If you see them around site, please do make them feel at home!



NEED SOME EXTRA HELP?

No need is too big or too small, and we'd love to try and help if we can.

Additional needs are wide ranging and can include physical, learning, mental health and undiagnosed needs. Find the accessibility team in the Sensory Space, where you can come for a bit of time out if needed at any point during the weekend.

Ask the team if you need help understanding the programme, or help accessing venues around the site. Within most venues you should be able to find some resources that might help you with joining in:

- · ear defenders if it's too noisy
- a fidget toy if you'd like something in your hands to help you listen
- some multisensory ways of joining in which don't involve using words
- leaders who will talk to you about what's going on and tell you about different ways you can join in.

You'll find accessible toilets marked on the map. If you need details of NEC Changing Places, ask the accessibility team.

The accessibility team will be hosting quieter meal slots. If that is helpful for you – come and chat to us to find out more.

On Saturday from 6.30pm there will be a 30-minute quiet session in the Tech Hub. If this will help you to access the space then please book a slot ahead of this time via the Sensory Space.

On Saturday and Sunday from 11am you'll be able to find us at the Big Worship gathering with ear defenders, fidgets and a space to retreat if you need one.






