THE EUROPEAN METHODIST FESTIVAL 2003

to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the birth of John Wesley, is to take place in Potsdam, Berlin, from Wednesday, the 30th July, to Sunday, the 3rd August.

THORNLEIGH TRAVEL, the Christian holiday company, is arranging coach travel to the event from various parts of the UK, and there is also an opportunity, for those who would like to extend their visit to Berlin, to include a holiday.

WHERE TO JOIN ONE OF THE COACHES?

Coaches will depart on Monday (28th July) from **Scotland** and the **North of England**; on Tuesday from the **Midlands** and **London**; picking up at **motorway services**. Those from the north take the luxury North Sea ferry from **Hull to Rotterdam**, with dinner, bed and breakfast on board; those from further south cross the Channel by ferry from **Dover to Calais**; both stop overnight in a hotel en route, with dinner, bed and breakfast.

The coaches leave Potsdam on Sunday afternoon, stopping again en route for dinner, bed and breakfast. Those using the Channel ferry will arrive back in the UK on Monday (4th August); those on the North Sea crossing, with dinner, bed and breakfast on board, arrive back on Tuesday.

HOW MUCH?

In addition to the Festival charges, the cost of travel by coach from Scotland and the North of England, including the North Sea mini-cruises, hotels en route and meals indicated, is £395 per person; from the Midlands and the South, including the Channel ferries, hotels en route and meals indicated, is £245 per person. Single room/cabin supplement overall is £66 and £26 respectively.

CHILDREN?

There will be a reduction for children sharing a room or cabin with parents.
