## Actions Taken

- 3 In accordance with the agreed procedure, the President of the Conference has appointed the following three individuals as protectors of the property held by the Methodist Schools Property Company under the Methodist Independent Schools Trust, to oversee the rights of the Conference in respect of the Trust for the connexional year 2022/2023: The Revd Dr Jonathan R Hustler, the Revd Peter Sheasby, Mrs Louise Wilkins.
- 4 Under the Council's delegated authority [MC/22/83], Mrs Joanne Anderton (Conference Officer for Legal and Constitutional Practice) gave consent to two cases involving the imposition of "Methodist" covenants on sale under Model Trust 20(2) and Standing Order 943(3): in respect of Scorrison Methodist Church, Buckfastleigh, and in respect of the former Methodist Chapel, Queen Victoria Road, New Tupton.
- 5 The Mission in Britain Fund (which is administered by the Council under Standing Order 362) is one of the beneficiaries under the will of the late Edith Joan Knight. The executors of the will are intending to sell the deceased's property and distribute the sale proceeds amongst the beneficiaries. The proposed sale price exceeds the probate valuation and the executors have taken the requisite advice in connection with the sale. The Conference Officer for Legal and Constitutional Practice has therefore confirmed the Council's approval to the sale.
- 6 There have been no Model Trust 20 applications to consider.
