### **Opening prayer**

Loving God, we come together today to worship you and give thanks for our JMA collectors. Bless our time together as we learn about people around the world. Amen.

### **General prayer (a)**

Dear God, we pray for the world. We pray for peace and justice. Help us all to glow and may your love for the world radiate through us as we serve you. Amen.

### General prayer (b)

Radiant God, we are excited to serve you. May the glow of the Holy Spirit fill our lives and guide us as we serve you.

In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

### **Prayer of Thanksgiving**

Thank you Jesus for the gift of the Holy Spirit as we serve our church and communities. May we glow and radiate with the love of God as you also served others by helping and healing people.

Help us to put into practice your teachings.

Your life and ministry show us how we should live and set an example of how we should act.

Help us to put love into action, and to spread your love around the world. Amen.

### **Offering prayer**

Generous God, we bring before you our JMA collections. May this money help people, programmes and projects in Methodist communities all over the world.

Bless this money and all those who have contributed to JMA with their prayers, time or donations.

Thank you, Generous God, that we can serve you through our JMA collections. Amen.

## Suggested prayer activitiy Placard prayers

### Material:

- White cardboard
- Colourful pens/pencils/crayons/paints
- Craft wooden sticks or resuse some old rulers
- Sticky tape

### **Preparation:**

- Make sure that you have risk assessed the surrounding areas.
- Make sure that none of your group have allergies for the materials you are using (eg paint).
- If you plan to use scissors, make sure the children are always supervised and/or that you use children's scissors.

### Instructions:

- Ask the children why they think it is important to challenge injustice.
- Once the children have shared, reaffirm their answers and build on their thinking.
- Explain to the children, and those gathered, that the 'A Methodist Way of Life' practice of 'Challenge' encourages us to 'challenge injustice'
- Ask the children and congregation to consider how we challenge injustice in our every day lives? Can our excitement and passion help JMA be part of challenging injustice in the world?
- Pause for thought, then play a collection of songs of your choice that you feel talk about challenging injustice. Let this be your background music as you create your placard prayers. (If you are stuck for a song to choose, visit methodist.org.uk/jmacs)
- Make your placard prayers by writing prayers on cardboard, and using to tape to place to a wooden stick or ruler on the back as a hand hold.
- You may want to display the placard prayers in/around your worship space or the children may want to take their placard prayers home.

- When the song playlist has finished, invite the children/congregation to read their placard prayers out aloud.
- When all the placard prayers have been read out aloud, together say 'Amen'.
