

Understanding the 3Gen programme and choosing the right activity for you

Next to each of the programmed activities in this booklet, you will find:





Session noise level

A little icon, indicating the level of noise and busyness we expect that session to involve:

- one bar means quiet and a few people
- two bars means medium noise and a bigger group of people
- three bars means we expect it to be noisy with lots of people.







Session length

A small clock, telling you how long we expect that session to last: 15 minutes, 30 minutes, 45 minutes or a full hour.









Session ages

An indication of the age group the session is pitched at or suitable for. This will be coloured to match the wristbands that participants of different ages wear, so if you can see your wristband colour, this session is more likely to suit you.

In the middle of this booklet there is a pull-out map of the site, with a programme on the reverse that you can personalise.

There are also lots of visual versions of the programme on screens and signs around site. If you need any help figuring out what you want to go to next, just ask one of our team members!

Helping you to join in fully

We want everyone to feel completely at home and able to join in at 3Generate. If you need any help engaging with parts of the programme, you can find the Accessibility Team in the Sensory Space. They can offer support with

understanding the programme, or accessing venues around the site. The Sensory Space is also where you can come for a bit of time out if needed at any point during the weekend.

Within most venues you'll be able to find the following resources:



Ear defenders if it's too noisy.



A fidget toy if you'd like something in your hands to help you listen.



Multisensory ways of joining in which don't involve using words or speaking.



A quieter space or area you can retreat to if you need a bit of a break.

Team members who will talk to you about what's going on and different ways you can join in.

Other Information

You'll find accessible toilets marked on the map. If you need details of NEC Changing Places, ask the accessibility team.

The Accessibility Team will be hosting 30-minute quieter meals inside the canteen space if that is helpful for you – come and chat to us to find out more.

On Saturday from 5pm there will be a 60-minute 'Sensory Space takeover' in the Tech Hub, when the venue will offer a quieter and more neurodiverse-friendly session.

On Saturday at 7.30pm there will be a 'Sensory pop-up' in The Arena, offering a quieter space while 3Gen Celebrates! takes place on the mainstage.

On Saturday and Sunday from 11am you'll be able to find the Accessibility Team at the Big Worship gathering with ear defenders, fidgets and a space to retreat if you need one.

Some sessions will be British Sign Language interpreted. Check in with the Accessibility team to find out more.

OTHER STUFF YOU NEED TO KNOW

Friday night



3Generate doors open at 7pm on Friday but we know that people arrive all through the evening. We therefore have very few programmed activities happening until after our official launch, **3Generate is go!** at 10pm in The Park. Instead, each venue will be welcoming you with a rolling programme that offers a glimpse of what lies ahead for the rest of the weekend. Take your time to explore the town, dropping into different spaces and finding out what's happening. If you are looking for something to get stuck into before we launch in The Park, then you can join in with the **Power of Drums** workshop from 8pm in The Arena.

Meals during the weekend

On Friday evening we will be serving a selection of street food from 8pm onwards. Collect your food when you've settled in!

Breakfast on Saturday and Sunday will be served from 7am to 9am.



Lunch and dinner on Saturday will both be served in two-hour slots (12pm to 2pm, 5.30pm to 7.30pm). You can turn up at ANY TIME during these two-hour slots and there will still be plenty of food available. There are loads of exciting things happening across the site during these times so have a look at the programme, choose the sessions you don't want to miss, and plan your meals to fit around them!

On Sunday we're encouraging you to pick up your packed lunch and gather in The Park with your group for a final act of **Big Worship**, including a picnic, before travelling home.

Big Worship



There are loads of opportunities around the site and throughout the weekend to tune in to God, but on Saturday morning at 11am in The Arena you can go all-in with some **BIG Worship** in our BIG space. On Sunday morning each venue will be offering a different worship style from 10.30am and then we'll be rounding up the weekend with Big Worship and a picnic in The Park at 11.30am.

3Gen Celebrates!



Every single one of the children and young people attending 3Generate has gifts and talents that are God-given and worthy of celebrating and encouraging - and that's what **3Gen Celebrates!** is all about. Throughout the Saturday of 3Generate, five different venues will be hosting open mic slots as part of their programme. We'd love for loads of you to sign-up (on Saturday morning from 8.30am in the Town Square) to share some of your creativity, personal expression, culture, art or testimony (tell us a personal faith story or about a time when you have been an agent of change in your community). The Arts Centre will also host a '3Gen Celebrates!' gallery as part of its venue activities on Saturday. This will all culminate with a show from 7.30pm on the mainstage in The Park on Saturday night. We'll hear about the amazing talents and stories that have been shared throughout the day and will celebrate together all the ways in which God gives us gifts and skills and calls us to be agents of change in the world.

Global Church Reps link with, and share stories of, children and young people in Methodist churches around the world.

Digital Reps manage digital communication for the Rep team and represent the youth voice in discussions around digital church.
