

Job Description:

Post: Families and Children's worker

This is a permanent post on a self- employed basis with the Church Leadership willing to support with self-employment polices/tax returns. Hours: 20 hours a week.

Salary: A contract of 20 hours per week @ £12.60 per hour for 39 weeks per annum, equating to £819.00 per calendar month.

Job Purpose: The key role involves working in the local community, through primary school works and being involved in local community groups, it would also involve supporting our children and teenagers in church.
