Maurice Aspey (23)	District Property Secretary, Darlington District.
Jane Dale (31)	Deputy legal manager at TMCP, supports the work of the ecumenical desk with expertise on Sharing Agreements and Constitutions for LEPs inter alia.
Jimmy Dube (31)	A Chaplain to the Zimbabwean Fellowship and in circuit ministry in the Birmingham District; brings with him the unique experience of serving the Church in Zimbabwe during the dictatorship.
Sarah Friswell (17)	The chair of the trustees of Epworth Old Rectory and former chair of the Methodist Heritage Committee. Sarah's current employment is as Visitor Experience Manager at St Edmundsbury Cathedral, Suffolk, with responsibility for visitors, volunteers and marketing. Previously, she was Head of Visitor Services at King's College, Cambridge, meeting the needs of students and visitors from across the world.
Carolyn Godfrey (24)	Carolyn has a background in special education teaching and has been a District Safeguarding Officer (DSO) serving two districts for a number of years. She will bring greater input from the DSO perspective into the committee.
Richard Goldstraw (3)	Having served nearly thirty years as a Deacon, he has wide experience in the Church and has recently finished five years on the Candidates' Selection Committee.
Tom Greggs (30)	A Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh, Tom is a theologian and the Marischal Professor of Divinity at the University of Aberdeen (the first Methodist appointed to this Church of Scotland academic appointment). He is a local preacher in the North of Scotland Mission Circuit, he serves on the World Council of Churches Faith and Order Commission and convenes the subgroup considering religious pluralism for Faith and Order. He also serves on the Faith and Order Commission of the Methodist Church.
Alistair Johnson (1)	Ali works for Cliff College as a digital evangelist, and is also a freelance digital consultant – helping churches including the Methodist Church in Britain to run digital projects. His roles involve equipping the Church to see digital as tool for sharing faith.
Chris Linford (26)	Northampton District Property Secretary, formerly Finance & Grants Officer for London Committee.
Jennifer Matthews (2)	Trained at the Queen's Foundation, and initially stationed in 2013 in the Cheshire South Methodist Circuit, where she had pastoral charge of chapels in both rural and urban locations. Now in her eighth year of ministry and starts her second stationing appointment in the Lincoln Methodist Circuit. She has a high regard for the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and uses the format of the Methodist Worship Book according to the liturgical seasons, with additional creativity throughout the service.

- Anne Mpendo (1) Anne is a financial sector development and integration expert with over twenty years of leadership and experience in East Africa (Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda, Burundi and South Sudan). This experience has entailed working with leading development partners, governments, academia, civil society organisations and the media in the East African Community Partner States to create a single investment space for the bank and non-bank financial subsectors.
- Karl Rutlidge (2) Presbyterian in the Kingston upon Thames Circuit. He is fairly new in ministry, so brings recent experience of having been through initial stationing. Having made a conscious decision not to apply for a dispensation as a Probationer Presbyterian for theological reasons, and being on the Organising Committee of the Methodist Sacramental Fellowship, means he brings a particular perspective and experience, but he stresses that he would of course apply the framework laid down by Conference as objectively and faithfully as he can.
- Richard Smith (16) One Methodist Forces Board member is always a 'Representative Chaplain' – a Methodist Forces Chaplain from one of the three military services. Representative Chaplains serve on the Board for two years. Following the end of the previous Naval Chaplain's two-year service (The Revd William C Gates), it is now the turn of an Army Chaplain to serve on the Board: Richard has been selected as the new Representative Chaplain by the Principal Army Chaplain, The Revd David J Barrett and the Secretary of the Forces Board, The Revd Christine M Howe.
- Holly Wilkinson (1) Holly is the Communications Officer for the Fundraising Regulator, the independent regulator of charitable fundraising in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. She has worked in communications and fundraising roles in several different charities, from local grant-making organisations to national health and homelessness charities. Holly has experience of serving on the Parish Church Council of her former local Anglican church, and is currently Secretary of the Church Council for her local Methodist Church.
- Sahr Yambasu (1) Sahr is President of the Methodist Church in Ireland. Born in Sierra Leone, Sahr moved to Ireland in 1995 following the civil war and he currently ministers in Waterford. Sahr has spent much of his life studying, challenging and addressing the causes and effects of poverty both in Sierra Leone and in Europe.
