Five Trustees of Methodist Independent Schools Trust are appointed by the Conference, normally for a three-year term. Nominations to the Methodist Council are made by the Trust.

Wesley Trust Trustees are appointed by the Methodist Council. Nominations to the Methodist Council are made by the Trust.
