### Summary of Content

Subject and Aims	This is a regular updated list of authorisations and delegations to clarify the discharge of consents required by Standing Orders and Model Trusts.
Main Points	SO 331(1) provides that the Methodist Council must appoint <b>a</b> Team Member to fulfil the duties assigned in the Model Trust and Standing Orders to the Property Secretary or General Secretary of the Property Division.
	SO 909 defines the appropriate connexional authority as the Methodist Council or any persons to whom it may delegate it powers.
	This report seeks to confirm who the Council has delegated their duties and responsibilities as the appropriate connexional authority to and who has been appointed as the Team Member for the purposes of SO 331(1).

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- The Model Trusts and Standing Orders contain many references to the responsibilities and duties of the Property Secretary or the General Secretary of the Property Division. However the roles of Property Secretary and General Secretary of the Property Division ceased to exist a number of years ago. Under SO 331(1) the Methodist Council annually appoint a member of the Connexional Team to fulfil the duties assigned to these roles.
- 2. Part 9 of CPD also provides that the appropriate connexional authority will undertake certain duties and responsibilities in respect of property matters. SO 909 defines the appropriate connexional authority as the Methodist Council or any persons to whom it may delegate its powers. This report therefore seeks to confirm to whom the Council have delegated their responsibilities as the appropriate connexional authority.
- 3. Since the last report to the Methodist Council in January 2013 with a list of authorisation and delegations the Law and Polity Committee has clarified that the Council do not have the power to appoint more than one member of the Team for the purposes of SO 331(1). The Council are therefore obliged to appoint one person to fulfil all the duties of the Property Secretary and General Secretary of the Property Dvision.
- 4. The Council has also previously been asked to delegate responsibility for approving different types of contract that fall under SO 931(3) to particular members of the Team. SO 931(3) does not require the Council to make such a delegation.

**931** Connexional Consent, Approval and Guidance (3) All contracts relating to property, conveyances, leasehold agreements, sharing agreements, deeds and declarations of every kind shall be forwarded in draft to the Connexional Team for inspection and approval before being signed.

- 5. The Council will however want to note that it is the Trustees for Methodist Church Purposes who act on behalf of the Connexional Team in inspecting and approving contracts before they are signed. This has been a long standing arrangement with TMCP and TMCP are paid from central funds for providing this service to the Connexional Team.
- 6. The Council will also want to note that even where TMCP approve a contract, it is still necessary for the Property Secretary or authorised connexional authority to sign a memorandum of before any disposition of Model Trust land can be completed.
- 7. The Council is asked to appoint Andrew Maxfield for the purposes of SO 331(1). The Council are also asked to approve the list of authorisation and delegations which relate to the Council's responsibilities as the appropriate connexional authority.

**Note** – Mrs Louise Wilkins, Conference Officer for Legal and Constitutional Practice will be on maternity leave from 31 January 2014 and therefore her maternity cover, Mr Andrew J Maxfield, is listed in the authorisation and delegations.
