Aim:

- To recognise, release and respond to the prophetic voice of children and young people.
- To hear the voice of children and young people within the planning, delivery and development of 3Generate, the children and youth assembly of the Methodist Church.
- To enable children and young people to listen to God, deepen their faith, be confident evangelists, and participate fully in the mission of their local church, including opportunities for enabling pioneering ministry and fresh expressions to emerge.

Satellite Group Member – Role Description

Role suitable for	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Warm, welcoming and friendly people.• Those with experience of working with children and young people.• Those who support the aims and principles of 3Generate and the vision for 3Generate 365.• Over the age of 18.• Creative individuals.
Accessibility / mobility	Volunteers will need internet access through a tablet or desktop to be able to fulfil the role of a 3Generate Satellite Group Member.
Role description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be part of a group of people developing and delivering a specific venue/area at 3Generate 2021.• Assist the Satellite Lead with the venue/area at the 3Generate 2021 event.• Help create an immersive space that facilitates children and young people in exploring and expressing their love for God.• Work alongside the Children, Youth and Family team to enable children and young people to be a prophetic voice.• Follow the guidance and vision set by the Children, Youth and Family team for the venue/area.
Tasks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read the briefing document and immersive glossary notes document to inform yourself on the vision for your group/area, and to make sure that other members of the group have read and understand this vision also.• Attend meetings, throughout the year on Zoom, with the designated satellite group members.• Listen out for the prophetic voice of children and young people throughout the year, through 3Generate 365, which will inform the planning of your venue/area.

General	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Familiarise yourself with the aims and principles of 3Generate 365. • Abide by the code of conduct for 3Generate 365, which will be provided for all volunteers and staff. • Adhere to the policies and procedures of The Methodist Church for the safeguarding and protection of children, young people and vulnerable adults, and to report any concerns or incidents using the 3Generate Policy and procedure outlined in the briefing documents.
Responsibility for other volunteers	None
Responsible to	Satellite Lead and the Children, Youth and Family Mission Team.
Time required	We estimate that this role will take the equivalent of 2–3 days per month.
Experience, skills, qualifications required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awareness of data protection and confidentiality issues. • Completion of Foundation safeguarding training. • Knowledge of how to use social media and communication platforms. • Leadership experience/potential.
Safer Recruitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Self-declaration • Telephone interview • Two references – one should be a minister. • A DBS check is required for this role. It may be possible to use an existing one if certain conditions are met.

The Methodist Church recognises that there will be a wide theological spectrum represented through the children and young people who attend the event and therefore this will need to be recognised by all those involved in facilitating over the weekend. It is possible that some of the views held by the children and young people may be at difference with your own views and we would ask that you respond to theological views sensitively and respectfully, ensuring that the range of views within any discussions are equally heard (whether programmed sessions or informal).
