

3Generate 365

Aim:

- To recognise, release and respond to the prophetic voice of children and young people.
- To hear the voice of children and young people within the planning, delivery and development of 3Generate, the children and youth assembly of the Methodist Church.
- To enable children and young people to listen to God, deepen their faith, be confident evangelists, and participate fully in the mission of their local church, including opportunities for enabling pioneering ministry and fresh expressions to emerge.

District Ambassador Team Member – Role Description

Aim: To communicate 3Generate 365 with local church, group leaders and children and young people within their district. To support and be an advocate for children and young people.

Role suitable for	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Warm, welcoming and friendly people.• Those with experience of children and youth ministry.• Those aged 18 and over.• 3Generate Volunteers living within the District.• Youth Reps Living within the District.• The role is open to all, in line with the Methodist Church Equality, Diversity & Inclusion policy.
Accessibility / mobility	Internet access through a desktop or tablet is important to undertaking this role.
Role description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be part of a team of District Ambassadors, who work together to be district advocates for 3Generate 365.• Be part of a team within the district, to encourage children and young people within their groups to participate in 3Generate.• Build up and empower young people across the district in circuits, churches and families.• Communicate with administrators, superintendents, youth leaders and other necessary individuals about the development of 3Generate 365 within each district, and encourage/inspire them to participate in the vision.• Attend briefings between September and December regarding your role.• Participate in and lead Zoom meetings with children and young people.• Learn to host said Zoom meetings with children and young people.• Interact with other district teams and share best practice.

Requirements	<p><i>All volunteers should:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Familiarise themselves with the aims and principles of 3Generate 365. • Abide by the code of conduct for 3Generate 365, which will be provided for all volunteers and staff. • Adhere to the policies and procedures of The Methodist Church for the safeguarding and protection of children, young people and vulnerable adults, and to report any concerns or incidents using the 3Generate policy and procedure outlined in the briefing documents.
Responsibility for other volunteers	<p>None</p>
Responsible to	<p>District Ambassador (Lead), Children, Youth & Family Mission Team</p>
Time required	<p>The role will operate between September and July and will require the equivalent of 2-3 days a month.</p>
Experience, skills, qualifications required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awareness of data protection and confidentiality issues. • Completion of Foundation safeguarding training. • Video conferencing. • Communication skills.
Safer Recruitment	<p>If already “safer recruited” into a District or Circuit role, this will be verified by the safeguarding lead for 3Generate.</p> <p>For those not previously safer recruited in a District or Circuit role:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A self-declaration • A telephone interview • Two references – one should be a minister. • A DBS check is required for this role. It may be possible to use an existing one if certain conditions are met.

The Methodist Church recognises that there will be a wide theological spectrum represented through the children and young people who attend 3Generate 365 and therefore this will need to be recognised by all those involved in facilitating 3Generate 365. It is possible that some of the views held by the children and young people may be at difference with your own views and we would ask that you respond to theological views sensitively and respectfully, ensuring that the range of views within any discussions are equally heard (whether programmed sessions or informal).
