



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PERSONS ON NOTE AND ON TRIAL

Study Units

Faith & Worship units, tapes and binders can be purchased from Methodist Publishing, 17 Tresham Road, Orton Southgate, Peterborough, PE2 6SG (☎ 01733 235 962). These materials are not available from the Methodist Church House, and all queries relating to them must be directed to MPH. The circuit is responsible for reimbursing those 'on trial' and local tutors from circuit funds, according to Standing Order 566 (3).

A *Faith & Worship* introductory pack, comprising Units 1-3 and a binder, is sent free of charge by MPH to those who are registered 'on note'. Discipleship & Ministries sends MPH the necessary information once the circuit has notified them. The process takes around two to three weeks.

Student Record Sheets

These sheets contain the assignments you need to complete in order to pass *Faith & Worship*. The assignments for Units 4-17 (Sections A, B, C and D) should be found at the rear of the relevant Unit.

Connexional Assessment Information

Detailed information about the procedures for submitting work for Connexional Assessment will be sent to you by Discipleship & Ministries once it has received notification from your circuit that you are 'on trial'.

Travel Expenses

It is a matter for each circuit to decide on a policy of travel expenses for local preachers, and the Discipleship & Ministries does not, at present, make any recommendation on this. It does, however, maintain the view that circuits have a moral responsibility to pay travel expenses. Preachers should be offered expenses (however this is done) and should not have to ask. Because conditions and traditions vary so much, no connexional policy is advocated.

Leaders of Worship and Preachers' Trust (LWPT)

Members of the LWPT (and occasionally others) can receive financial help to assist them if they are in necessitous circumstances. Those seeking help should contact their local branch secretary or, if that person is unknown, the LWPT Head Office (☎ 01923 231 811).
